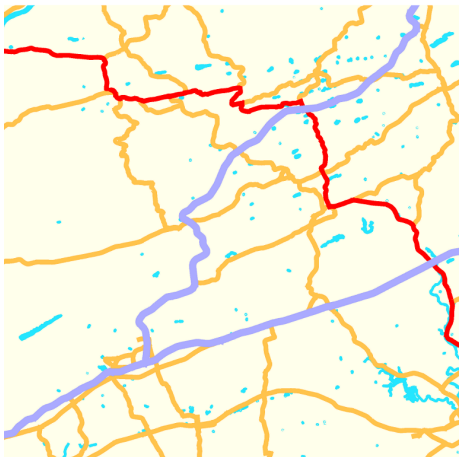

## Camino Inglés, from Ferrol to Santiago - Spain

The **Camino Inglés**, also known as the English Way, is an ancient pilgrimage route once walked by travellers from Northern Europe who reached Spain by sea, disembarking in **Ferrol**. Following this **meaningful 120 km journey to Santiago de Compostela** means retracing the footsteps of centuries of pilgrims, surrounded by landscapes rich in history and symbolism.

Pilgrims arriving by boat would step ashore in **Ferrol** and begin their walk toward **Santiago de Compostela** along what we now call the **Camino Inglés**. This quiet and soulful route unveils the serene beauty of rural Galicia: **lush hills, timeless villages, eucalyptus forests and the warm colours of the Spanish countryside**. It's an ideal choice for travellers seeking a more intimate, reflective experience – far from the crowds of the French Way, and perfect for reconnecting with the land, its people and yourself.

### Route

#### Day 1 Arrival in Ferrol

Starting in **magical Ferrol** means soaking in its mysterious atmosphere, walking around the **Magdalena district** with its 18.th century buildings and the **the Naval Museum and San Felipe Castle**, with its geometric layout and magnificent stonework, and the impressive hydraulic architecture of the **dockyards** - a unique example in Europe.

#### Day 2 From Ferrol to Pontedeume, 31 km

The adventure starts in **Curuxeiras, Ferrol's port**. the first gem of the day is the **San Martiño de Xubia Monastery**, built in the 8th century - legend tells that between the temple and Neda there was a tunnel allowing monks to cross the river without being seen. Several highlights await - the pastires and bread of Neda, the climb to Monte Marraxòn, possibly a swim in Magdalena beach. Pontedeume - today's destination - is well known for its Torre de los Andrade and one of the longest medieval bridges in Europe.

*Distance: 31 km*

*Elevation Gain: +239/-233 m*

#### Day 3 From Pontedeume to Betanzos, 21 km

A challenging, but gorgeous stage awaits - plenty of ups and downs, the Galician Forest with its tranquil atmosphere, trails immersed in nature, **and** suburban roads in **Betanzos**, which awaits us protected by its ancient walls.

*Distance: 21 km*

*Elevation Gain: +493/-479 m*

#### Day 4 From Betanzos to Hospital de Bruma, 28,3 km

Charge up with a good breakfast, as the longest stage of the journey lies ahead of you: challenging, long, but beautiful - a walk **through forest and meadows, laurel forests and small villages**. Today's destination is **Hospital the Bruma**, named after the ancient hospital that would welcome pilgrims in this area.

*Distance: 28,3 km*

*Elevation Gain: +928/-564 m*

#### Day 5 From Hospital de Bruma to Sigüeiro, 24,8 km

A flat stage through **mountains, forests, and farmland**, passing through picturesque **villages**, each with its church. The route follows the **Mandeo River** before arriving in the medieval village of **Sigüeiro**, where you can rest and get ready for next stage.

*Distance: 24,8 km*

*Elevation Gain: +243/-408 m*

#### Day 6 From Sigüeiro to Santiago de Compostela, 16,5 km

Today's route - flat and almost completely asphalted - passes through several small villages before arriving in the **outskirts of Santiago de Compostela**. **Enjoy the panoramic view** of the city before **reaching the Plaza del Obradoiro - an emotion you will never forget**.

*Distance: 16,5 km*

*Elevation Gain: +406/-358 m*

#### Day 7 Arrivederci, Santiago de Compostela!

Last day included. Service ends after breakfast.
