



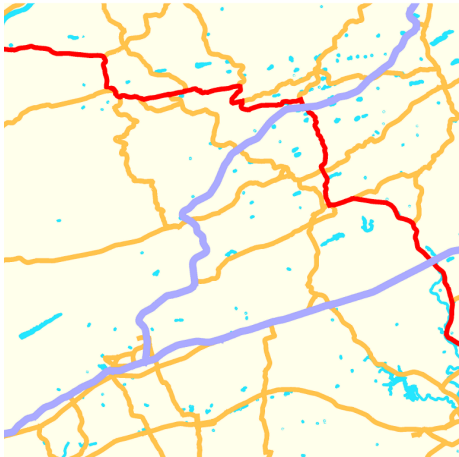

Experience a Tuscany walking holiday and enjoy an active hiking adventure!

Start in **Florence**, then wander through the **rolling hills of Chianti**, where **vineyards, olive groves**, and **cypress-lined roads** paint a **quintessential Tuscan landscape**. End this leg in **Siena**, with a leisure day to explore its historic streets and lively piazzas. Next, walk through the **golden fields** and **gentle hills of Val d'Orcia**, dotted with **medieval villages** and stunning **viewpoints**, until you reach **Montalcino**, famous for its **wines**. The **journey concludes** with a train ride to **Rome**, where you can immerse yourself in the **Eternal City's breathtaking history, iconic monuments, and vibrant piazzas** — an unforgettable finale to your Tuscan adventure.

Perfect for travelers who love to explore actively, this trip **blends walking, culture, and authentic Italian experiences**.

Route

Day 1 Arrival in Florence

Arrive in **Florence** and take a moment to breathe in the air of the Renaissance.

We suggest you to arrive early to **go for a city walk around the magnificent squares and by the illustrious Arno River**.

Taste the **local cuisine** and enjoy the variety of Tuscan dishes! You won't be disappointed!

Day 2 Walk from Settignano to Fiesole, 14 km

Travel uphill on a local city bus ride to the village of **Settignano** where the walk begins.

On the walk, you have magnificent views of **cypress trees, olive groves, Renaissance villas** and the whole city of Florence at your feet.

Stroll through the charming town of **Fiesole** and tour its **Etruscan ruins, Roman amphitheater and Franciscan monastery**.

Distance: 14 km

Elevation Gain: +535/-535 m

Day 3 Greve in Chianti Loop

After breakfast you will be transferred to **Greve in Chianti**, a rustic market village and the capital of the **Chianti wine** producing region.

Check in to the hotel and head over to **Le Cantine di Greve** where you can taste over 50 different Chianti wines. Take advantage of the daylight to walk around this gorgeous scenery.

Greve Loop via Montefioralle, 8 km:

Explore the wonderful **surroundings** through the forest, among dense **wild vegetation, villas, vineyards and olive groves**. You will be passing by **abandoned old farms, ruins and beautiful villas** before reaching the panoramic hamlet of **Montefioralle**.

Distance: 8 km

Elevation Gain: +300/-300 m

Greve Loop via Uzzano, 8 km:

A rural undulating walk with great vistas through **forests and wine fields**. Leaving the town of **Greve in Chianti** the walks leads uphill through the countryside and past the castle of **Uzzano**. Great views of the classic **Chianti landscape with vineyards** and olive groves all around, and the Appenine mountains in the distance.

Distance: 8 km

Elevation Gain: +245/-245 m

Day 4 Panzano Loop, 11 km

You walk through the hills surrounding the village, in the **classic Chianti** landscape that **alternates forests with vineyards**, offering you the possibility to discover **ancient Roman farmsteads**.

Distance: 11 km

Elevation Gain: +330/-330 m

Day 5 Morning Transfer and walk to Radda in Chianti, 13,5 km

After breakfast, a short **car transfer takes you to the highest of the Chianti hills, Monte San Michele**.

You will be dropped off in the village of **Badiaccia a Montemuro** where you start the walk, descending through a forested valley of century old chestnut trees.

A short climb brings you to the **stunning medieval hamlet of Volpaia**, situated amongst **vineyards and castles**. Stop in for a **glass of red at a fine Enoteca (wine shop)**.

The last part of the walk is through the **typical Chianti landscape woods and vineyards**, passing by the **Pieve di Santa Maria**, on the other side of the valley you can already see **Radda in Chianti**, one of the most renowned villages of the area.

Distance: 13,5 km

Elevation Gain: +430/-610 m

Day 6 Transfer to Siena

After breakfast, a pre-arranged private transfer will take you to the marvelous city of **Siena**. **History comes alive as you meander through the narrow streets** of this fantastically preserved jewel of Italy.

Day 7 Leisure Day in Siena

Situated along three ridges at the southern end of the **Chianti hills**, **Siena** is another **UNESCO city not to be missed**. The town explodes with excitement during the famous Palio horse race run several times over summer in Piazza del Campo. The striking **Duomo** is **jam-packed with artworks by Bernini, Michelangelo and Donatello** and is only one of many fascinating sites to explore during your stay. Today is **free to explore this exciting town**; art galleries, museums, atmospheric squares, churches, boutiques, gelaterias – the choice is endless!

Day 8 Walk from Siena to Lucignano d'Arbia, 21 km

After breakfast take start off on your wonderful **Via Francigena trip** along the astonishing **Tuscan countryside**. Walking alongside cultivated meadows, with its **colours changing from the greens and yellows of spring and summer to ochre's of Autumn**, you will pass through the medieval village of **Cuna**, just a few hundred meters before entering the town of **Monteroni d'Arbia**, with its famous **watermill**. The last part of the walk leads you to the fortified hamlet of **Lucignano d'Arbia**, along its characteristic **cypress tree-lined entrance**.

Distance: 21 km

Elevation Gain: +165/-325 m

Day 9 Walk from Lucignano d'Arbia to Buonconvento, 14 km

Today's walk is through a series of **rolling hills and wheat-cultivated meadows** in the heart of the "**Crete Senesi**", a clay area that never ceases to amaze the passer by, with its **distinctive grey coloured soil** that makes it **look like you're on the moon**. Your destination for today is the walled town of **Buonconvento**, rightly considered **one of the most beautiful villages in Italy**.

Distance: 14 km

Elevation Gain: +70/-100 m

Day 10 Walk from Buonconvento to Montalcino, 16 km

Today you **detour off the main route of the Francigena** as you climb through the amazing landscape of the Val d'Orcia, with its gentle, rolling hills and the cypress-lined dirt roads leading to solitary farmhouses. The climb through **groomed vineyards** is one of the trip's highlights: the world-famous fortified town of **Montalcino**, "**capital**" of the **exquisite red wine "Brunello"**.

Distance: 16 km

Elevation Gain: +470/-195 m

Day 11 Leisure Day in Montalcino

A day at leisure in **Montalcino** is a journey into the heart of Tuscany's **serene countryside**. Mornings begin slowly, perhaps with a stroll through the charming medieval streets, where stone buildings and quiet piazzas invite reflection. **For wine lovers, a visit to a local vineyard offers a tasting of the famed Brunello di Montalcino**, paired with breathtaking views over rolling hills. The afternoon can drift by with a **relaxed lunch of Tuscan specialties**, a visit to the imposing fortress, or simply sitting at a café, watching village life unfold. As the sun begins to set, the **golden light bathes the countryside, creating the perfect backdrop for a gentle walk or a quiet moment of contemplation**, making the day a seamless blend of relaxation, culture, and natural beauty.

Day 12 Travel to Rome

After breakfast, a pre-arranged private transfer will take you to Chiusi Chianciano train station from where you will take a direct train to Rome.

Day 13 Arrivederci, Rome!

The trip and our services end after breakfast unless you have booked extra services with us.

From Florence airport, take the direct local bus to the city center.

On Departure:

In Rome you can reach the airport by either bus or train.
