



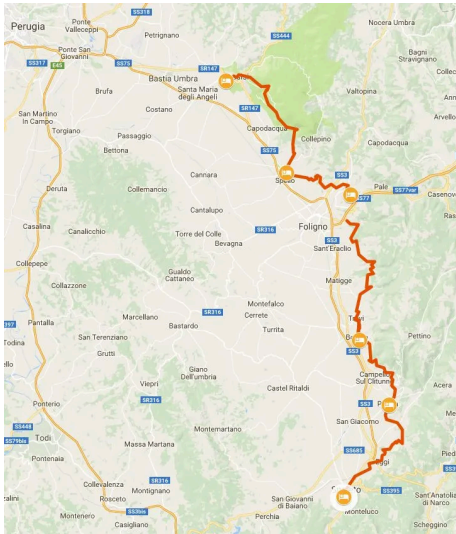

St. Francis Way, Stage 4 Assisi to Spoleto - Italy

Travelling in the **footsteps of Saint Francis** through **Umbria**, the green heart of Italy: you will perceive his humble spirituality in following his footsteps through forests, vineyards and olive groves, surrounded by green hills sprangled with medieval villages. This **St Francis pilgrimage in Italy** takes you across authentic landscapes full of peace and history. You will visit towns where time seems to have frozen: from **Assisi**, where you will be able to visit the wonderful **Basilica** and walk in the **Saint Francis wood**, to **Spello**, with its streets full of flowers and the medieval towers. And finally Spoleto, which enshrines in its artistic richness the influence of all the people who have inhabited it.

The foodies will appreciate the **tasty Umbria kitchen**: recipes based on simple ingredients, such as extra virgin olive oil and cereals, home made pasta with meat sauces and typical desserts such as the **torciglione**, whose recipe is passed down from one generation to the other.

Route

Day 1 Assisi

You will start from Assisi, where you will be able to spend your day visiting the most meaningful places of Francis' life: from the **Basilica crypt**, where millions of people go to visit the Saint's grave, to the **Porziuncola**, the little church around which the Santa Maria degli Angeli Basilica was built. You will discover a perfectly preserved **Roman temple** in the middle of the city, and enjoy a unique view from the top of the **Rocca**. Finally, enjoy the sweetness of Rocciata: it's a dessert similar to a strudel, which is said to have been brought to Assisi by the Longobards people.

Day 2 From Assisi to Spello, 15,3 km

Your first day of walk will lead you from Assisi to **Spello**: you will ascend the **Monte Subasio** through a wonderful uphill path until reaching the "Eremo delle Carceri", where you can gather in prayer in the caves where Francesco and his companions used to meditate. The itinerary continues through an oak wood to the **San Benedetto Abbey**, built in the IXth century, today closed for restoration. You will later reach the medieval city of Spello through a downhill path: enjoy an evening walk through its stone made houses, whose balconies are typically decorated with flowers.

Distance: 15,3 km

Elevation gain: +385/-1005 m

Day 3 From Spello to Foligno, 10 km

Before setting off you will be able to visit the medieval city of Spello: the two imposing towers defending **Porta Venere** are worth a picture, but we suggest visiting the rich rooms of the **Municipal Palace**, and visit the **Santa Maria Maggiore church** to admire some Pinturicchio and Parmigianino frescoes. Today walk will lead you to the vibrant town of Foligno from where you can enjoy stunning views of the surrounding mountains and valleys.

If you want to walk more, in the morning you can opt for a very nice round walk via Collepino village.

Distance: 10 km

Elevation gain: +371/-233 m

Day 4 From Uppello to Bovara di Trevi, 20 km

A brief car transfer will take you to **Uppello**, where your walk starts. A steep climb will lead you to the Rocca of Scandolaro, once in defense of the surrounding territories. You will continue through an oak wood until **Trevi**, where you may want to taste the famous olive oil. Walking through an ancient aqueduct you will reach Bovara di Trevi.

Distance: 20 km

Elevation gain: +593/-580 m

Day 5 From Bovara di Trevi to Poreta, 12 km

From Bovara di Trevi you'll follow the original "Francis Way", the original path walked by the same Francis, until reaching **Campello Alto**, surrounded by wonderful views on the Spoleto valleys. Worthwhile of admiration are the convents of Pissignano and Campello, where you'll be able to gather for a few minutes, enjoying the meditative atmosphere permeating these places, surrounded by olive trees.

Distance: 12 km

Elevation gain: +461/-541 m

Day 6 From Poreta to Spoleto, 15 km

Today, a narrow trail will lead you to the **Santa Maria di Reggiano** hamlet: visit the ancient monastery to admire the XIIth century frescoes, to later continue to the hamlet of Eggi. You will walk along a dismantled railway line until **Spoleto**. You can make a detour for a longer but spectacular entry into the city, passing high above the Tessino stream on the medieval aqueduct that bridges the valley. Once in Spoleto you'll be able to recite your favorite poem in the Roman theatre, let the simple beauty of the **San Salvatore Basilica** enchant you, or celebrate the end of your journey with a nice dinner: the local pride is the black truffle, to be enjoyed on a bruschetta, or powdered on an omelette.

Distance: 15 km

Elevation gain: +488/-454 m

Day 7 Spoleto

Accommodation

Country House Tre Esse - Assisi

Country House Tre Esse is located 400 m from the centre of Assisi with views of the Umbrian countryside. It's surrounded by the green and it offers an external swimming pool. Rooms are comfortable and equipped in a simple way with air conditioning/heating, TV, free Wifi. Breakfast buffet is various and rich.



Hotel Il Cacciatore - Spello

Hotel Il Cacciatore*** is centrally located in Spello, nestled into the slopes of Mount Subasio. It offers basic rooms with furniture a little bit dated, but clean and spacious with free Wifi, TV, telephone with direct line. The hotel has a terrace overlooking the valley. Breakfast is good and rich.

Agriturismo I Mandorli - Bovara di Trevi

Agriturismo I Mandorli is an Agriturismo run only by women located in Bovara di Trevi, 30 minutes from the city center of Trevi. It offers basic accommodations with rustic style with free Wifi, TV, heating and an external swimming pool. Owners are kind and helpful. Breakfast is simple but good, with savoury and sweet dishes.



Agriturismo Borgo della Marmotta - Poreta

The Agriturismo Borgo della Marmotta is located near the little hamlet of Poreta halfway between Spoleto and Trevi. The origins of the village date back to the seventeenth century, but an attentive restoration was recently completed. Location is very quiet and relaxing, like the comfortable rooms with a canopy-bed, air conditioning/heating, free Wifi, TV and electric kettle. Staff is nice and helpful.



Hotel Charleston - Spoleto

Hotel Charleston is centrally located in Spoleto and it offers refurbished and well-furnished rooms with parquet floors and original paintings. These offer free Wifi, mini bar, air conditioning, telephone, TV. Breakfast is good and the staff is courteous and kind.

Practical info



From Rome airports (FCO, CIA), you need to get to the railway station and take a train from there to Assisi (either direct or with change in Foligno).

From Florence airport (FLR) and Pisa airport (PSA), you need to get to the railway station Santa Maria Novella in Florence, and take a train from there to Assisi (either direct or with change in Terontola-Cortona and Perugia).

On departure from Spoleto, there are direct trains to Rome, whereas you need to change if you need to get to either Pisa or Florence.
