




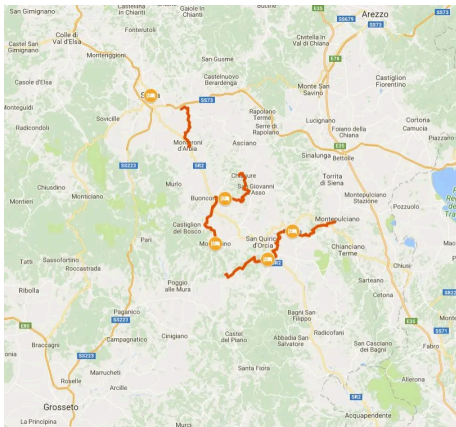

Val d'Orcia, Montepulciano to Siena

The Tuscan landscape of the **Val d'Orcia** will warm your heart like a classic photograph as you penetrate its natural beauty. You are in for a thrilling ride along steep valleys, dense forests, rivers and the legendary “badlands” eroded clay slopes. Walk by picturesque farmhouses nestled amidst olive groves, vineyards and fig trees on your way to the hot spring hamlet of **Bagno Vignoni** and the heavenly Renaissance city of **Pienza**. You shall visit captivating palaces, Romanesque churches, thermal baths, and prestigious wineries serving the divine local red “**Brunello**”. Soaring up high on invigorating hilltop towns, you'll revel in delight.

Route

Day 1 Arrive in Montepulciano

Your Tuscan walking begin in the medieval and **Renaissance hill town of Montepulciano**. Montepulciano is easily accessible via Rome, Florence or Pisa; catch the train to Chiusi then take a local bus or a short taxi ride to Montepulciano. Admire the impressive views over the rolling Tuscan landscape that you'll be exploring over the next week.

Day 2 Walk from Montepulciano to Pienza, 13 km

Starting from the **San Biagio church** you follow a quiet track to the peaceful village of Montichiello where you can pause for a relaxed lunch or perhaps just a quick cappuccino before continuing to **Pienza**. Pienza is a **UNESCO World Heritage** site with unique Renaissance architecture. The town is well known for its delicious pecorino cheese and truffles; this is a great spot to indulge in Tuscan treats!

Distance: 13 km

Elevation: +384 / -504 m

Day 3 Pienza to Bagno Vignoni, 12 km

Today you wander through a beautiful region of rolling hills, oak woods, cypress trees and pretty villages. The thermal baths complex at **Bagno Vignoni** is the perfect location to spend the afternoon soaking up the Tuscan warmth.

Distance: 12 km

Elevation: +197 / -418 m

Day 4 Transfer to Castelnuovo dell'Abate, walk to Montalcino, 13 km

A transfer will take you to Castelnuovo dell'Abate in the morning. A more challenging but rewarding day's walking awaits as you follow dry riverbeds through a fairly wild environment to **Sant'Antimo**, an isolated **abbey** situated in a pastoral landscape.

Distance: 13 km

Elevation: +450/ -280 m

Day 5 Walk from Montalcino to Buonconvento, 15 km

A hearty breakfast will set you up for a long but enjoy day of walking in the famous **Brunello wine region**, passing vineyards and olive groves, then again entering the beautiful Tuscan landscape of the **Crete Senesi** and **Buonconvento**.

Distance: 15 km

Elevation: +316 / -619 m

Day 6 Loop walk to Monte Oliveto Maggiore Monastery, 14 km

A short day which is full of ups and downs, beginning with a transfer to the **monastery at Monte Oliveto Maggiore**, an impressive abbey built of red brick and set in the rugged Tuscan landscape. After an early visit to avoid the crowd, walk back to **Buonconvento**.

Distance: 14 km

Elevation: +382 / -460 m

Day 7 Transfer to Monteroni d'Arbia and walk to Arbia, train to Siena, 11 km

Today you will start with a short transfer to **Monteroni d'Arbia** from where you start the walk to Arbia. Hike through a landscape of rolling hills and small hamlets as the unmistakable sight of Siena appears in the distance. It's an easy and scenic walk on dirt roads through the Crete Senesi. Along the route you can stop and visit the San Fabiano castle. A train will then take you from Arbia to **Siena**.

Distance: 11 km

Elevation: +227 / -187 m

Day 8 Depart from Siena

Last day included. Tour ends after breakfast.

Accommodation

Nights in double rooms in 3/4* hotels and agriturismo with breakfast



Hotel Il Duomo - Montepulciano

Hotel Il Duomo is housed in a 16th-century building in Montepulciano's historical centre. It has not so spacious rooms, but clean and well-finished with satellite TV, minibar, private bathroom, free Wifi and heating. Breakfast is both sweet and savoury and during spring and summer it's served outside. Staff is welcoming and courteous.



Piccolo Hotel La Valle - Pienza

The Piccolo Hotel La Valle is equipped with all comforts and facilities, 15 well-kept rooms furnished in Tuscan classic style, some with balconies facing the Val d'Orcia, the garage for cars, motorcycles and bicycles. Customers will be welcomed and well looked after and thanks to its family management, care and selection of products, they will be able to discover the excellence of the area and at the same time feel at home.



B&B La Locanda del Loggiato - Bagno Vignoni

B&B Locanda del Loggiato is housed in a 14th century building in Bagno Vignoni, one of the most magical spa villages in Tuscany. Rooms are elegant, well-finished and comfortable, each one with own furnitures. These have free Wifi, own heating/air conditioning, terracotta flooring and old wooden beams. Staff is courteous and welcoming.



Hotel Giglio - Montalcino

It was obtained from an ancient palace built near the castle walls of the city of Brunello. At this point you look out over the Crete and Siena with a dizzying view. Il Giglio is a small three-star family run, with passion and simplicity.



Agriturismo Pieve a Salti - Buonconvento

This Farmhouse is nestled in the rolling hills of Siena housed in an old tuscan building of the 19th century outside Buonconvento. Rooms are well-furnished with rustic style, not so spacious, but clean and comfortable with TV, minibar, air-conditioning. The restaurant is open at dinner and it offers biological tuscan cuisine. Staff is helpful.



Hotel Chiusarelli - Siena

The three-star Hotel Chiusarelli is located in the city centre of Siena, finds its natural setting in a neoclassical villa built around 1870. The structure has been completely renovated in 2013. Rooms are spacious and clean and these offer bathroom with shower or bathtub, hairdryer, air conditioning/heater, telephone, Wi-Fi, TV with Sky Vision. The Hotel has no lift. High quality breakfast.

Practical info



From Florence airport (FLR), take the bus to Santa Maria Novella train station and then a train to Chiusi Chianciano (and then take the bus to Montepulciano).

From Pisa airport (PSA), take the train to Chiusi Chianciano (with 2/3 changes, depending on time).

On departure from Siena reach the train station.
