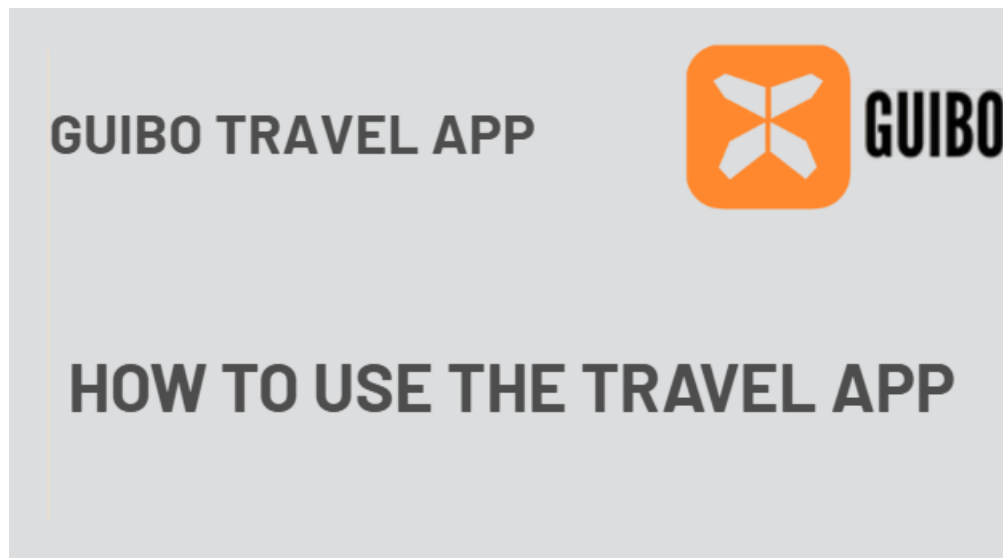


GUIBO Travel App

Complete User Guide

This guide explains how to install and use the GUIBO Travel App to follow your cycling or walking routes during your trip.

Note: The GUIBO app is updated from time to time, so the layout, colours and position of the buttons on your phone might look somewhat different compared to the examples shown in this manual. However, the functionality will always be more or less the same.



Quick Start Guide

- Download the GUIBO app from the App Store or Google Play.
- Open the app and enter your Operator ID and Booking ID.
- Download your trip guidebook.
- Select your travel day in Tour Itinerary.
- Tap the route name and press Start Route Navigation.
- Follow the blue route line.

Extra Tips:

- Set the volume of "Media" and "Notification" to maximum level.
- Set location services to Always On and allow notifications for the GUIBO app.
- For Samsung devices à language settings à "Text-to-speech output" à Preferred engine: Google instead of Samsung.

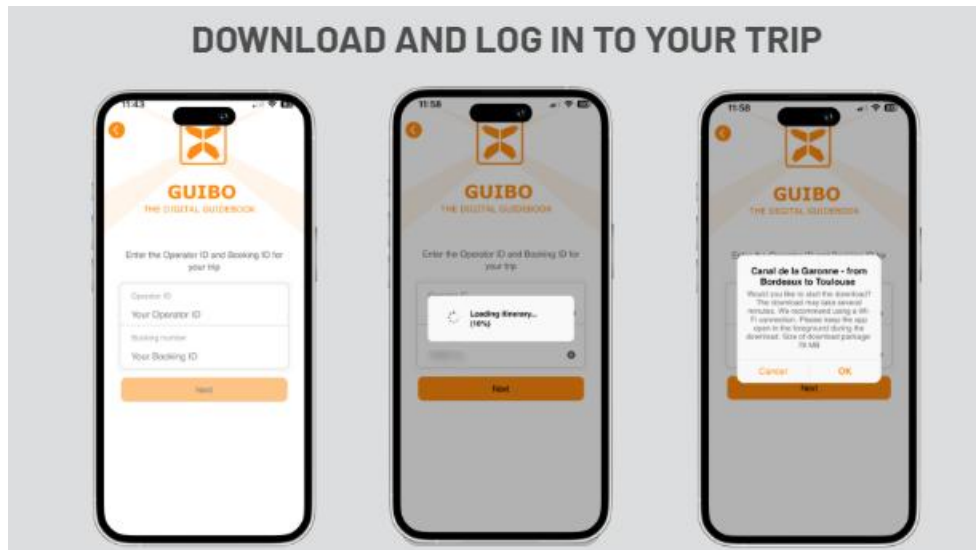
Install the GUIBO App

Download the GUIBO app from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store and open it.



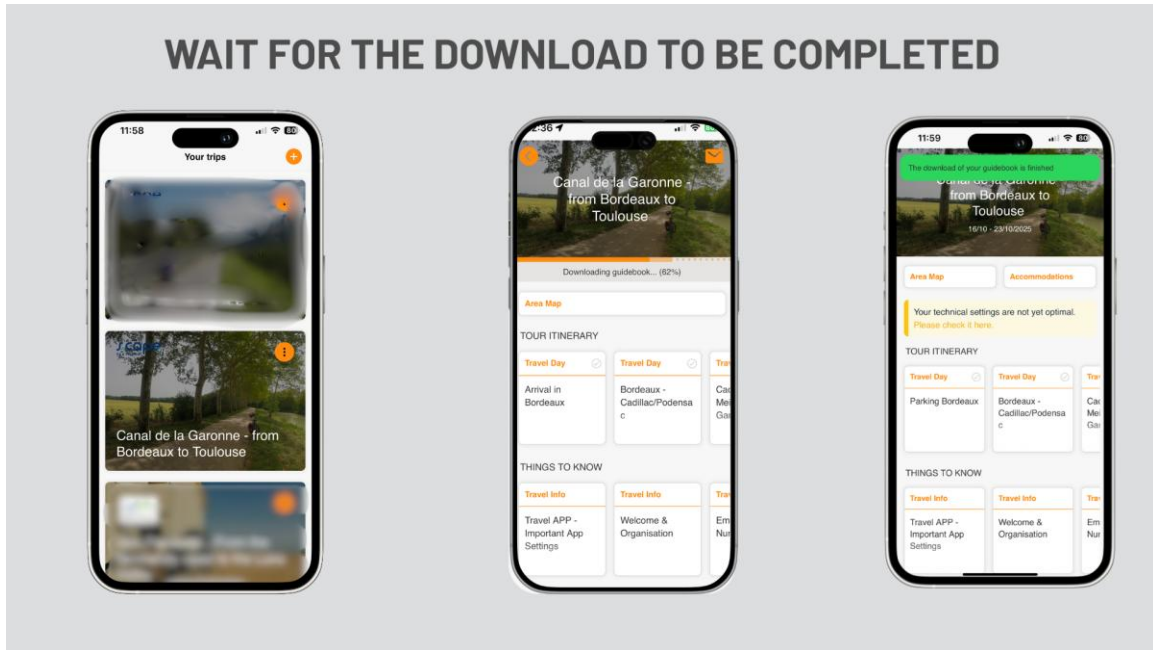
Log in to Your Trip

Enter the Operator ID and Booking ID (download code) that you received before your trip.



Download Your Guidebook

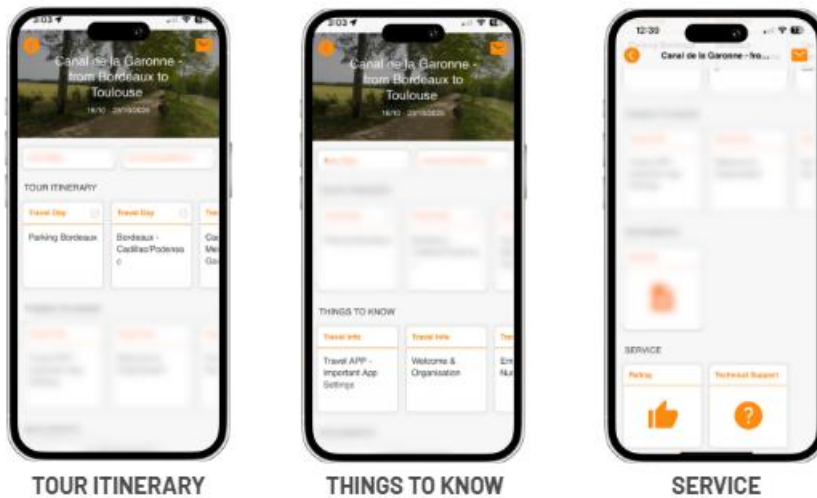
Confirm the download of your trip and keep the app open until the download is complete.



Main Menu Overview

The main screen gives access to Tour Itinerary, Things to Know and Service.

THE 3 MAIN CATEGORIES



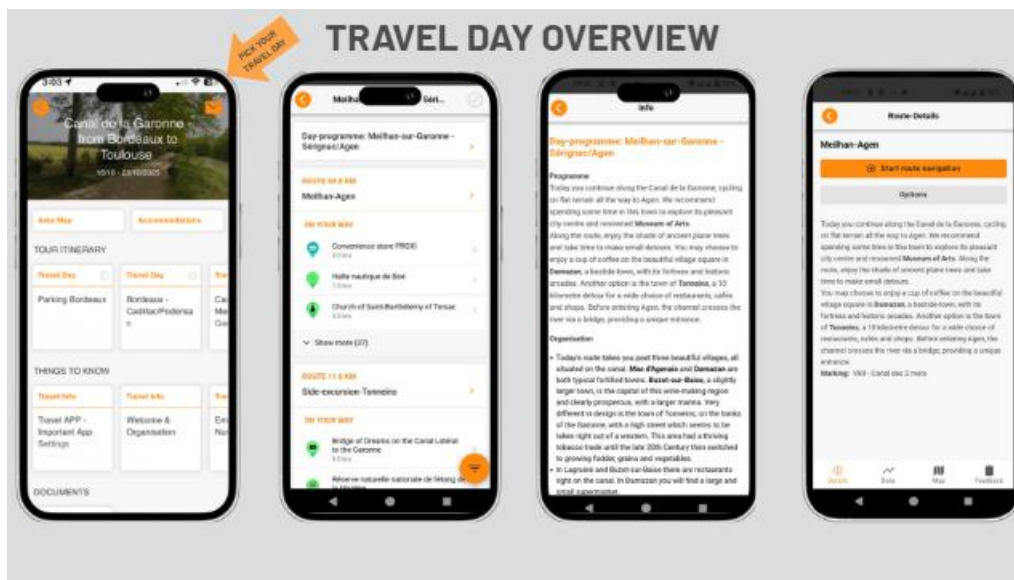
Area Map and Accommodations

View the overview map of your trip and the list of accommodations booked for your journey.



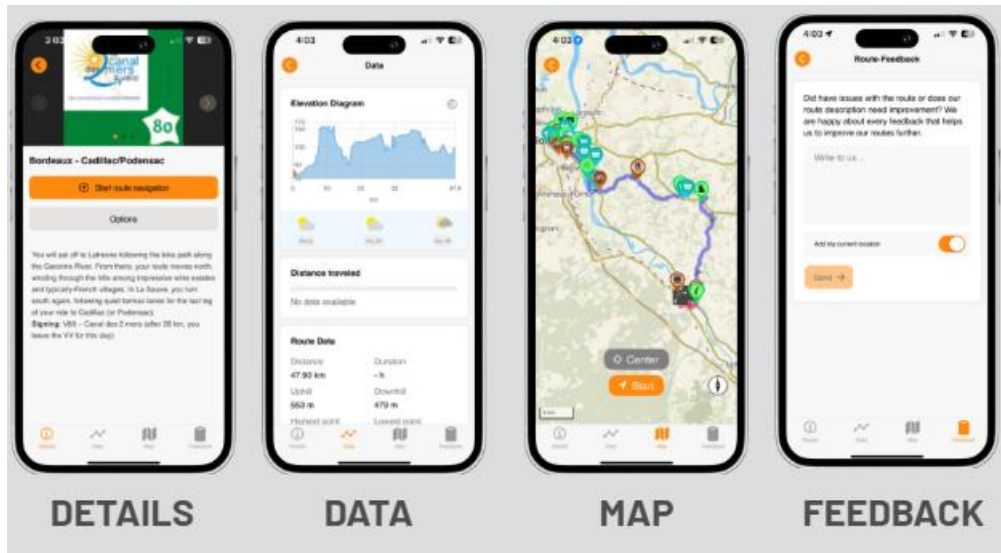
Tour Itinerary

Select the travel day you want to explore and open the route details.



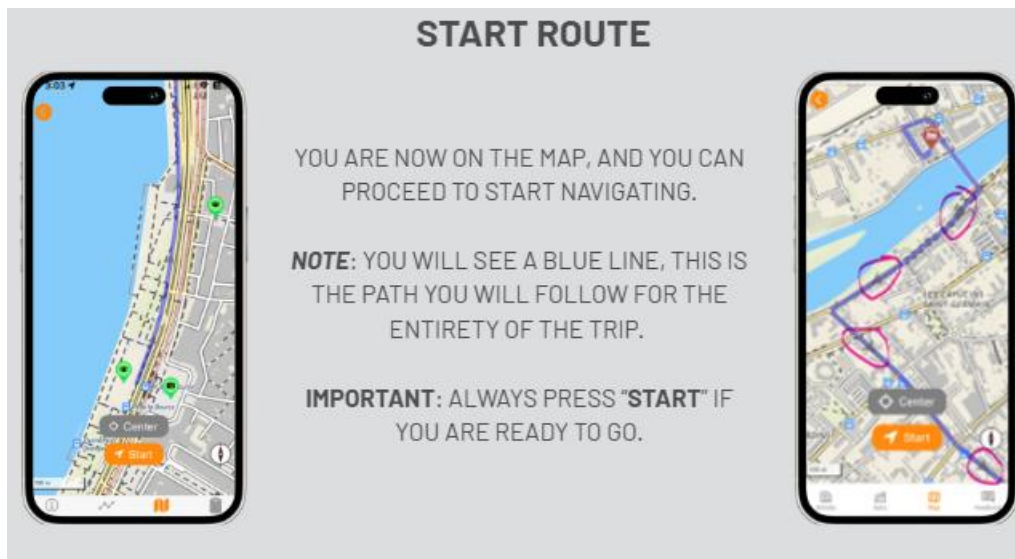
Route Details

Each stage contains four tabs: Details, Data, Map and Feedback.



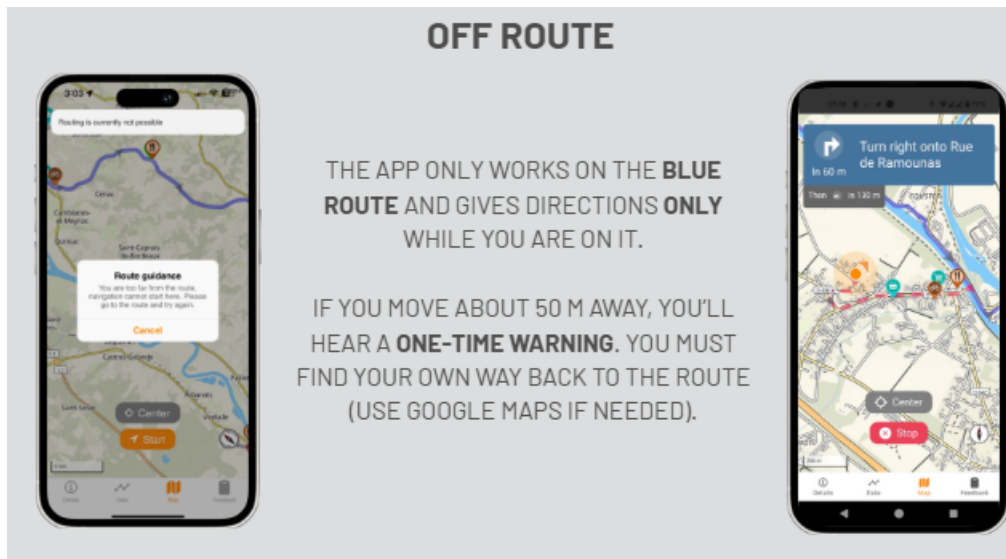
Start Navigation

Tap the route name and press Start Route Navigation to begin your stage.



Following the Route

Follow the blue line and the directional arrows shown on the map.



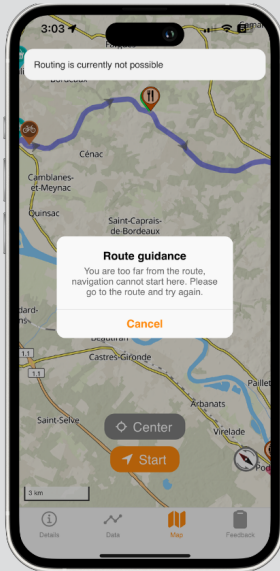
- if upright: map stays in north-south orientation (often useful when hiking).
- if oblique: map rotates along with your movement (recommend for cycling/driving).

If You Leave the Route

Navigating to a POI (Point Of Interest) outside the route is not yet possible in-app. Instead, click on the POI, and select "External Navigation".

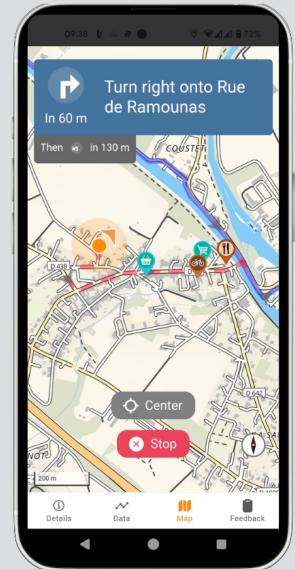
If you leave the route by accident or on purpose, the app can now guide you back to the route: Simply click on "Stop", then click "Start" and the app will calculate a route back (shown as a red-dashed line). Once back on route, press "Continue".

OFF ROUTE



THE APP ONLY WORKS ON THE **BLUE ROUTE** AND GIVES DIRECTIONS **ONLY** WHILE YOU ARE ON IT.

IF YOU MOVE ABOUT 50 M AWAY, YOU'LL HEAR A **ONE-TIME WARNING**. YOU MUST FIND YOUR OWN WAY BACK TO THE ROUTE.

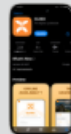

- A WATERPROOF SMARTPHONE HOLDER
- A FULLY CHARGED EXTERNAL BATTERY (POWER BANK)
